Where can I purchase the CELTO or CELTO+TEYL

How does it work & what happens once you've paid?

Within 24 hours of enrolling in the **CELTO** course you will receive login details for the **INTESOL Online Campus**. The **CELTO** course consists of 8 units. Each unit has course notes, self-checks and assignments that you will study at your own pace. Once your final task has been graded by your assigned tutor you will submit your completion form to begin the certification process.

At the beginning of the course you will be assigned a course tutor who will be in charge of marking your tasks, providing feedback and correction and answering any questions you have. Most of the contact with your tutor will be via email and they are always pleased to help if you have any difficulties.

With 40 hours' worth of work in the course, most people complete it within 2 to 4 weeks. Need more time, no problem, work at your own pace. You will receive comprehensive course materials and full support from a qualified tutor. Can anyone enrol?

How does the assessment occur?

CELTO:

1 Auto-marked test at the end of each unit (8 tests total) with an unlimited number of attempts allowed.

1 Tutor-marked assignment at the end of the CELTO course assessing candidates' understanding of key concepts from various parts of the course.

Candidates may have a maximum of three attempts.

CELTO+TEYL:

1 Short tutor-marked assignment at the end of each unit (8 total) assessing the candidates understanding of the key concepts of the unit.

Candidates may have a maximum of three attempts.

Note:

The course material can be accessed and read in any order, however it is recommended to progress from unit to unit in the order of the course, first going through **CELTO** and then through **TEYL**. The next assessment (whether it be test or assignment) is not opened until the previous one has been passed.

Will I receive a certificate?

Yes. INTESOL will issue a certificate to you upon successful completion of the course. Alongside is a sample of what it would look like
